- 1. Classes: Please see attached letters from Liz Reid for Grade 6 and Grade 7 Program explanation and dates.
- 2. Retreat
- 3. Successful completion of a written Evaluation
- 4. Worship:
 - · Regular Mass attendance on weekends and Holy Days of Obligation along with your family.
 - · All candidates are to be trained as either Altar Servers, Ushers, or Lectors, and serve such Ministry on a regular mass schedule, or Participate in the Youth and/or Contemporary Youth Choirs.
 - · Attendance at Eucharist Adoration and Rosary.
 - · Attendance at Stations of the Cross.
- 5. **Service Projects**: Candidates for Confirmation will do class projects and can choose individual or group service projects (approx.. 15 hours of service in the community or at events).
- 6. **Interview with a Clergy Member:** Each Candidate will also have an interview with a member of the clergy sometime during the preparation program. All forms and assignments must be turned in before scheduling an appointment.
- 7. **Reconciliation Services:** The Candidate along with their families is to attend a Family Reconciliation Service during Advent and Lent
- 8. Rehearsal: Sponsors & Candidates are to attend. Please be prompt
- 9. The Sacrament of Confirmation will be conferred by Bishop Frank Caggiano in 2024 for 7th Graders and 2025 for 6th Graders.
- 10. **Confirmation Names**: Candidates must prepare a one-page essay on a Saint whose life they wish to emulate and whose name they will take at Confirmation. This must be a Saint recognized by the Catholic Church.
- 11. Sponsor Certificates. The Sponsor obtains the Certificate from their parish.
- 12. Family participation at Mass, regular reception of Eucharist and Reconciliation and Service Project.

Dear 6th Grade Pre-Confirmation Students and Parents:

This year, our parish 6th graders and students from 3 other parishes in Norwalk will continue the Multi-Parish Collaborative Youth group which began last year. This exciting new program will feature some class instruction and lessons, but will also encompass a Norwalk community wide middle school gathering of young people for Mass, activities, and collaboration. You will be learning and developing ways of sharing and living your faith.

This means that your 6th grade religious education program will be comprised of one monthly Sunday evening class at St. Matthew including attendance together at the 5pm Mass, and one Sunday monthly session at All Saints School with the candidates from the other parishes.

In the past our 6th grade pre-confirmation program was held at our church on two Sundays a month. So instead of that the program will be one Sunday at church and one Sunday at All Saints School.

Students who currently attend All Saints School (or another catholic school) will only have to attend the collaborative sessions at All Saints School (cost \$100). Their curriculum for religious studies is otherwise handled at school. Any student who wishes to register for Confirmation next year, must attend the All Saints Collaborative class one Sunday a month.

PLEASE NOTE THE DIFFERENCE IN TIMES: THE SUNDAYS AT ST. MATTHEW WILL BE FROM 5pm—7:15 (INCLUDES 5PM MASS and CLASS FROM 6:00-7:15) AND SUNDAYS AT ALL SAINTS SCHOOL WILL BE FROM 4PM-6:15PM (INCLUDES MASS AND SNACKS EACH SESSION).
